In this constantly evolving world, when we are drowning in information yet starving for wisdom, we at Bihani Academy, Joka are committed to ignite the minds of the students to dream big so that they become future leaders who are erudite, patriotic, law-abiding citizens with a deep concern for all. Our school team works relentlessly to foster morally upright, intellectually luminous, and physically sound leaders who have the insight and courage to lead the world, and we can't thank the parents enough who have stood by us like one big extended family," shares Mousumi Mohapatra, principal, Bihani Academy.

BACK TO OFFLINE MODE

"After having been restricted in a closed environment for more than one and half years and having to adjust to an extraordinary routine, coming back to school seems to have set the children free. They have been very enthusiastic and upbeat about being back in school. They were eagerly looking forward to resuming in-class learning. They are coping well with the Covid-19 protocols in place at school and have already taught safety measures as part of their daily habits," avers Mousumi.

MONITORING FEEDBACK

Regular online classes from Nursery to class VIII are being conducted. Extra enhancement classes are also being held after school hours to support students. "Our school counselor is conducting regular classes and seminars for specially-abled children. The teachers are in constant touch with the parents to ensure immediate inputs, which reinstate our steps on the right path. Parents' and students' feedback are closely monitored to guarantee that effective teaching-learn-

ing is taking place. As per the state government and CBSE guidelines, we have resumed offline classes for students from classes IX to XII in school premises since 16th November, 2021. Routine classes are being held from 8:45 AM to 2 PM from Monday to Friday/ Saturday. We are continuing with most classes in online mode for standards X and XII keeping in mind that their Term 1 board exams are in progress. However, some parents are still hesitant to send their child anywhere outside the home during the pandemic. To bridge the gap, we have adopted the practice of classes in hybrid mode so that no child misses out on learning. Our approach is a judicious mix of offline teaching and online learning," she assures.



FACULTY TRAINING SESSIONS

Several in-house workshops and training sessions were conducted for teachers and non-teaching faculty and support staff before the school reopened. These sessions were targeted towards sensitisation and defining measures to reassure safe operation and learning conditions to help minimise and prevent the virus from spreading among school communities. As a result, everyone was made aware of the immense responsibility on their shoulders because of the pandemic and because children are coming back to school after a long gap.

CHALLENGING ADAPTATIONS

The faculty constantly felt that a laptop could not replace a blackboard and chalk. The lack of physical interaction and the very sight of children in a classroom, which is so motivating, was a hurdle that the teachers learned to overcome with

Initially, while using common platforms for online classes, students complained of technical glitches and network issues at home, but they were soon resolved by switching to a more integrated, private forum. Classes were scheduled on MS Teams in addition to the fully functional 'Bihani Academy' app.

COVID SAFETY PROTOCOLS

Wearing a mask is a must for every person on the school premises. In addition, whoever comes to school must go through stringent thermal screening and hand sanitization processes before stepping inside the campus. "Our children and faculty are encouraged to practice safe distancing. We had also ensured that all our faculty members are fully vaccinated before the school reopened," she shares. In addition, parents had to submit a duly signed 'consent letter' allowing their child for offline classes; a practice also followed before a child avails school bus facility.

INFRASTRUCTURAL USP

"We are proud to exhibit a campus which spreads over 6 acres of land, with 70% green cover area. We are tucked in a noise-free and pollution-free zone that provides maximum comfort to all in its environs. We have well-ventilated, smart classrooms and dedicated Computer, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, Geography, Home Science and Language labs along with two well-stocked libraries and a canteen. Our infrastructure supports a wide array of indoor and outdoor sports. In addition, we can boast of a 400-seater auditorium and an open-air amphitheater which is a first of its kind in the city," shares Mousumi. The school also offers boarding facilities with separate, in-campus hostels for boys and girls for classes IV and above students.

HOLISTIC WELLBEING

Mousumi explains, "We strongly believe that a healthy balance between academics and extracurricular activities is what ensures holistic wellbeing of any child. Therefore, our school indulges in several indoor and outdoor activities to ensure each of our students' physical, emotional, moral and cognitive development."

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Indoor activities entail squash, table tennis, billiards, chess, martial arts, yoga and meditation, dance, eastern music, western music, carom whereas outdoor sports include cricket, football, basketball, volleyball, badminton, swimming, skating, boxing. Apart from these, the school also conduct regular events for notable days and participate in national and international level competitions to widen their students' exposure.
